A total of 20 film and audiovisual projects in advanced development from Argentina, Colombia, Chile, Spain, Mexico, Portugal, Uruguay and United States will participate.

Iberseries & Platino Industria has selected the projects that will participate in the **Series and Feature Film Co-Production and Financing Forum**. This will take place on **October 4 and 5** at **Matadero Madrid**, as part of the **third edition** of the **biggest Latin audiovisual event** of the year, promoted by **EGEDA** and **Fundación Secuoya**, with the collaboration of **FIPCA** and the support of **Madrid City Council** and the **Community of Madrid**.

The **Co-Production and Financing Forum** also has the support of **ICEX Spain Trade and Investment**, through its umbrella brand, **Audiovisual from Spain**. This entity supports the international promotion of the content and services offered by Spanish production and distribution companies by maintaining a constant presence in major markets at festivals and networking events.

The organizers will draw up a personalized **one-to-one appointment** schedule with professionals interested in the selected projects.

The **Forum** will promote and facilitate connections with **co-production, co-financing, broadcasting, and distribution** partners, with particular emphasis on those projects that serve to strengthen ties on **both sides of the Atlantic**. The main goal is to promote the development of projects with high levels of production and to **strengthen co-production models** between relevant stakeholders in the Latin American and European audiovisual sector, as well as to promote **Latin talent**.

The series **Frágiles**, the first success story of the Iberseries & Platino Industria Co-Production and Financing Forum

Frágiles, a series by the Argentine production company **StoryLab** and **Flow**, an on demand platform for live and streaming content, began **filming** at the end of March and is expected to **premiere** in the second half of 2023.

This major production created by **Nacho Viale** and **Diego Palacio**, directed by the latter, was presented at the **first edition** of the **Iberseries & Platino Industria Co-Production and Financing Forum** last year. During the event, the project was selected to take part in the **SoloSeries** section of **Ventana Sur 2022**.

The thriller series, starring Luciano Caseres, Carla Quevedo, Malena Sánchez, Ludovico Di Santo, Andrés Gil, Rafael Spregelburd, and Ana Celentano, centers on the investigation of a succession of

sinister murders that unveil a web of crimes and dark secrets from the past that are linked to a cult. Over the course of the 8 episodes, Olivia, a young assistant of a powerful Spanish prosecutor, and Roman, a young man raised in the cult, cross paths in search of a terrifying truth that ties them together forever.
